

Internet Download* (How to Download or Save Files from the Internet)

Do you want to find information which is easily available and quick to find? You can use the Internet for saving or downloading files. Internet download is accessing information from a web browser, email browser or other similar systems and saving it to a computer. The information can be in the form of documents, images, music or even movie. Data is transferred from a remote computer to a local computer. Some downloads are legal, i.e. permission is not required for saving those files. For other downloads, materials are copyright protected, i.e. permission is required from the source to save those files. There are also some files like music and movies which can only be downloaded on payment.

***Note:** The download of files that are copyright protected and/or that require permission from its source are not encouraged.

Internet Download usually involves:

- Starting an Internet browser
- Selecting the information you want to download
- Downloading or saving files from the Internet

Steps on Internet Download or How to Download or Save Files from the Internet

A. Select a Web site

1. Start the web browser.

2. Click to place your cursor in the Address or Location bar. Type the Web site address or keywords for the information you want.

Download Files from Internet

3. **Press the Enter key on your keyboard.** You will notice that a list of Web sites will appear.
4. **Click on a Web site that interests you.**

Note: To select a Web site, move your cursor over it. You will notice the cursor changes to a hand 

B. Select and Download File

1. **Scroll through the Web site page you just selected.**
2. **Download an image or picture.**

3. **Download a document.**
