**JOINDER OF HEWLETT-PACKARD COMPANY TO OPPOSITION BY DELL INC.
AND INTEL CORPORATION TO AMENDED MOTION TO MODIFY PROTECTIVE
ORDER AND APPROVE PROTOCOL FOR UNSEALING DOCUMENTS**

Hewlett-Packard Company (“HP”) hereby joins in the legal arguments made by Dell, Inc. and Intel Company in opposition to the amended motion of the New York Times Company, Situation Publishing Ltd., Dow Jones & Co., Inc., The Washington Post, the Reporters

Committee for Freedom of the Press, and the Computer & Communications Industry Association (collectively, “Movants”) to modify the Confidentiality Agreement and Protective Order and for approval of a protocol for unsealing documents. HP opposes the Movants’ motion to the extent it seeks access to HP’s confidential information in filings with the Court.

Pursuant to subpoenas from the parties, HP has produced a large number of documents and did so in reliance upon the protections provided to it under the Confidentiality Agreement and Protective Order. At an absolute minimum, HP should be consulted and have an opportunity to object before any HP confidential information is provided to or reviewed by Movants in any form.
