Dear Judge Poppiti:

The parties provide this joint report pursuant to Amended Case Management Order No. 6, dated June 20, 2008, which requires within fifteen days of the end of every second month that the parties “jointly report on the number of hours of depositions each has expended during the preceding two months and any issues relating to the progress of the depositions, or any other issues, that have arisen in connection with the depositions.”

**Number of Hours of Depositions Expended by Each Side**

During the preceding two months, May and June, the parties expended the following numbers of hours:

For depositions taken in May, Intel 167.50 hours, AMD and Class 161 hours;

For depositions taken in June for which the parties have final transcripts, Intel 196 hours, AMD and Class 134.5 hours. There were two additional deposition sessions conducted in Japan in the last half of June for which the parties are not yet able to provide firm numbers for the hours used because they have only rough transcripts. Based on the rough transcripts, however, the parties estimate that they used the following numbers of hours in those two sessions: Intel 8.5 hours, AMD and Class 1.0 hour.

Thus, the estimated totals for the two months are, Intel 372 hours, AMD and Class 296.5 hours.



Since submitting their previous joint report in May, the parties have re-evaluated the hours previously reported for April 2009, and have agreed that the total previously reported for Intel for April was too high by 0.25 hours, and the total for AMD was too low by 4 hours. Accordingly, the correct total number of hours used by Intel through April is 645 hours, and the correct total for AMD and Class is 888.5 hours. Therefore, the cumulative total numbers of hours the parties have used since the Court adopted Amended Case Management Order No. 6 through the end of June are:

Intel – 1,017 hours, AMD and Class – 1,185 hours.

### **Other Issues in Connection with Depositions**

Other than matters that have already been brought to Your Honor's attention, there are no new issues relating to the progress of the depositions or any other issues that have arisen in connection with the depositions that the parties believe presently require Your Honor's attention.
